9. **Hill Aerospace Museum Open Aircraft Day:** HILL AIR FORCE BASE, Utah – The Hill Aerospace Museum’s third annual Open Aircraft Day is Saturday, September 14 from 9 am - 4:30 pm on the Museum grounds outside of Hill Air Force Base. Admission is free and open to the public. This year’s highlight will be a presentation about the F-35 from F-35 Pilots and Crew at 10:30 a.m. and 1 p.m. The special event will also include: food, live music, face painting, Hill Air Force Base unit demonstrations / displays, and a chance to explore several aircraft open to the public only for this event. Open museum aircraft includes the F-15, F-16, F-106, KC-135, MiG-17, MiG-21, C-119, A-10, P-40, P-51, and more. A variety of food trucks will be on hand for attendees to purchase food and drinks.
